

## Information for New and Potential Members

Thank you for your interest in the Glenmore Club. We are an active friendly walking club, with a membership of about 120. We have a varied programme of outdoor and indoor meets. Our main programme runs from September to June.

We publish a quarterly newsletter. This contains more detail on the meets, for example where we are staying, the cost of the accommodation etc. Each meet is organised by a co-ordinator, their name and contact number for is given in the newsletter. A place on weekend meets is booked through the co-ordinator. The newsletter contains details of our current outdoor programme. You will see that we organise both weekend and day meets. The day meets are within easy travelling distance of Glasgow; the weekend meets tend to be further afield. At weekends we stay in hostels, bunkhouses or camp.

We also organise indoor meets. These are held in the **Hyndland Bowling Club, Queensborough Gardens, Glasgow**. Indoor meets start at 07.30. pm.

We share transport and so, although you can just turn up for day meets, it is normal practice to let the coordinator know you are going particularly if you require or can offer a lift.

Typically 15 to 40 people attend out door meets. We split into small groups for walking. This is done informally; we do not organise walks of different grades. Most people tackle munros or corbetts. We do not organise climbs as such although occasionally individuals in the club get together to climb. The club has a small amount of equipment it lends out, for example ice axes and crampons until people new to winter walking get their own gear.

Though membership details and a copy of the Application form are available on the web site, we normally suggest that you come along to a few meets (either indoor or outdoor) to see what we are about before committing yourself. Please feel free to just turn up at any indoor meet, but for outdoor meets you should contact the meet coordinator (details in the relevant newsletter) in advance.

We look forward to seeing you at a meet in the near future.
